TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AUCTION

1. Consignors must be members of the NDBA.
2. All bison must have the following or they will NOT be unloaded:
 - a. **Health Certificate from a certified veterinarian**
 - b. **Permanent metal ID tag placed in the RIGHT EAR by a veterinarian**
 - c. **NDBA dangle tag placed in the LEFT EAR, remove all other tags**
3. All animals will be tagged in the left ear with assigned NDBA tags for identification. There is a non-refundable **\$2.00** tag charge per animal consigned.
4. All bison must be checked in no later than **4:00 p.m. CST**, Friday, January 9th, 2014.
5. Animals must be in salable condition, bison sold **"AS-IS"**, and any guarantees are between buyer and seller.
6. **Bison become the responsibility of buyer when Auctioneer declares SOLD.**
7. **Commission fee is 7%.** On no sales the last bid will apply for determining commission. The following scale will serve as a guideline for commission on animals brought to NDBA Consignment Auctions.

# of Animals	Consignment Fee
1 – 200	7%
201 – 350	6%
351 – 499	5%
500 or more	4%

8. **The NDBA does not insure death loss. This is the owner's responsibility.**
9. Please make every effort to sort the animals before coming to the sale barn.
10. There will be a check-off contribution to the NBA for marketing bison. \$1 will be taken out of all consignor checks per animal consigned, which will be matched by the NDBA. You must let the office know if you do not wish to participate in this program.

11. Any damage done to the facilities at Napoleon Livestock by cows will be the responsibility of the owner.
12. Animals must be hauled out of Napoleon Livestock by **6pm on Saturday, January 10th, 2015.**

Please **read all of these instructions before working your buffalo** for the NDBA sale. Keep these rules for reference when working your animals and **make sure your vet reads these rules as well.**

1. Each buffalo must be listed on health papers along with their corresponding metal ID tag and NDBA dangle tag. Each animal must be represented on a single line of the health papers i.e. if there are fifteen lines on the health form only 15 animals should be on that sheet.
 - a. The NDBA dangle tag goes in the left ear. The permanent metal ID tag goes in the right ear.
 - b. All animals coming from ND or SD do not need to be Bangs or TB tested, but do require the health paper and tags as listed above. Other states will be looked at on a state-by-state basis. If your state's requirements are the same as ND, you may consign or buy without any further testing. If your state's requirements are not the same as ND, then you will have to follow your state's rules as a buyer or seller.
 - c. **Although there are no health requirements, the NDBA strongly encourages bangs vaccinations. History has shown that those animals bring more money.**
2. If females are pregnancy checked it must be noted on the health paper.
3. Females are sold as open or bred only. There is no such thing as pasture exposed.
4. Commission fee is 7% on all buffalo.

The following scale will serve as a guideline for commission on animals brought to NDBA Consignment Auctions.

# of Animals	Consignment Fee
1 – 200	7%
201 – 350	6%
351 – 499	5%
500 or more	4%
